Domenico Ferrari is an italian/swiss composer, producer and electronic musician born in Zurich, Switzerland. From 1991-1995 he studied composition and guitar at Jazzschool Lucerne. At the beginning of his musical work he more played a role as a jazz musician achieving also the „Werkjahr der Stadt Zürich“ in 1996, a cultural award by the City of Zurich. Then he opened his horizon more and more for electronic aspects in music and works also as composer for movie scores.

He worked with the newyorcan spoken word poet Latasha Diggs for his 2003 album "Commute"; in a collaboration with Jamie Lidell for "Moods Club" in Zurich in 2005, with Jojo Mayer and Prohibited Beatz among others

In 2006 he co-produced with Mario Beretta the filmscore for „Vitus“, an awarded movie Fredi Murer.

This winter, he also worked on „H.R. Gigers Sanctuary“, a documentary about the artist H.R. Giger, who achieved international fame with his work on Ridley Scott's „Alien“.

D.F.'s last work has been released by the legendary label Verve Forecast (Universal). Actually he lives in Rome, at the Istituto Svizzero Roma, working on his new album and composing music for several filmprojects.
