Nenad Stojanović (Sarajevo, 1976) is Associate Professor of political science at the University of Geneva, Senior Researcher at the Centre for Democracy Studies in Aarau, Privat-Dozent at the University of Lucerne and, in Autumn 2025, a Visiting Professor at the University of Bologna.

Nenad's main area of research is democracy, particularly participatory democracy and democratic institutions in multicultural and multilingual societies. He is the author of *Dialogue sur les quotas: Penser la représentation dans une démocratie multiculturelle* (2013; Italian translation: 2014) and *Multilingual Democracy: Switzerland and Beyond* (2021). He is active in organising and/or providing scientific support for citizens' assemblies drawn by lot, in Switzerland and beyond (demoscan.ch). In the context of a partnership between the universities of Geneva and Zurich he has founded and leads the Swiss Research Centre on Democratic Innovations (unige.ch/pidem). He is also the Co-editor-in-chief of the *Swiss Political Science Review*.

Outside of his academic work, he enjoys reading (especially Italian literature and authors from the former Yugoslav republics —listening to classical music, opera, and jazz, exploring contemporary architecture, and spending time swimming, skiing, or hiking
